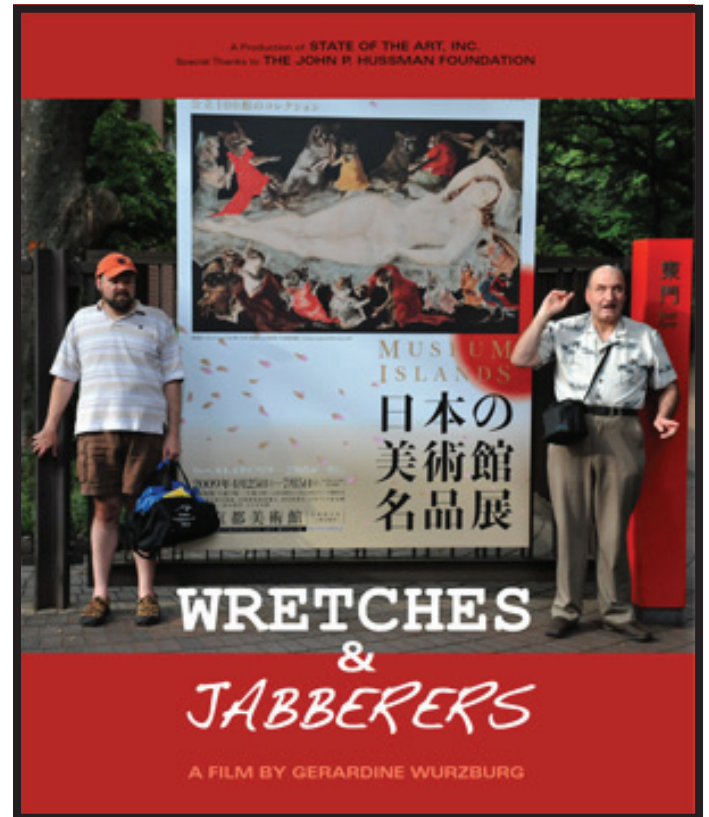




are pleased to announce a special screening of ***Wretches & Jabberers*** a documentary film by Gerardine Wurzburg
